1 Kings 3:5-12


⁵ The LORD appeared to Solomon in Gibeon in a dream at night.


THE SECOND LESSON



the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.


PRAYER OF THE CHURCH


